


• Read over the provided material prior to the start of your installation



Level Intermediate Posts Installation Steps




 Using a measuring tape, measure from bottom of handrail to the mounting surface



- Cut Intermediate Post to the measurement from the previous step with any device appropriate for cutting stainless steel
- Remove any burrs with a file
 Helpful Tip:
 At this point, you can use this Intermediate Post as a
 drilling guide for your wood posts. This will ensure that
 all of your cable holes line up.




 Slide the Foot Cover then the Intermediate Post Mounting Bracket (Foot) onto the cut end of the Intermediate Post




 Mount the top end of the Intermediate Post into the handrail with the provided screws



Level Intermediate Posts Installation Steps (Continued)



 Make sure the post is vertical, then screw the Intermediate Post Mounting Bracket into the mounting surface with the provided screws



- Slide the Foot Cover over the Intermediate Post Mounting Bracket
- The foot cover can be secured with silicone or epoxy if desired




Things to Know Before You Get Started

• Read over the provided material prior to the start of your installation







Angled Intermediate Posts Installation Steps



• Run string the length of your angled run to simulate the bottom cable of infill



• Hold the Intermediate Post up to the bottom of the handrail with the bottom hanging off the side of the stair




 Slide post to find where a cable hole will line up with your bottom cable (string)




 Once you've found the proper post location, mark the cut length for the post



Angled Intermediate Posts Installation Steps (Continued)




- Cut Intermediate Post to the measurement from the previous step with any device appropriate for cutting stainless steel
- Remove any burrs with a file



 Covering the post top with a rag to protect the finish, use pliers to bend the post top to the appropriate angle



 Slide the Foot Cover then the Intermediate Post Mounting Bracket (Foot) onto the cut end of the Intermediate Post



 Mount the top end of the Intermediate Post into the handrail with the provided screws

 Make sure the post is vertical, then screw the Intermediate Post Mounting Bracket into the mounting surface with the provided screws



- Slide the Foot Cover over the Intermediate Post Mounting Bracket
- The foot cover can be secured with silicone or epoxy if desired
