


# Universal Bracket Handrail Installation Guide



## Things to Know Before You Get Started


• Read over the provided material prior to the start of your installation


#### **Universal Bracket Handrail Installation Steps**



- Set the bracket on top of the post dome
- Using one screw, temporarily attach the handrail bracket to the post dome

#### Note:


To prevent possible corrosion, only use the supplied chrome plated Allen wrench when doing this step



- Select the relevant handrail for the run you are working on
- Lay the handrail upside down on a protected surface
- Measure the run and mark the cut length for the handrail



• Using the appropriate blade for the handrail material, cut at the mark



- Remove any burrs and tap the plug in place with a dead blow hammer
- Optional Step: Run a line of silicone or epoxy around the handrail plug to hold in place



### **Universal Bracket Handrail Installation Steps (Continued)**



• Place the cut handrail on the posts brackets and clamp in place




• Using a pencil or pen, mark the bracket outline or the pilot holes for the handrail screws



- Remove the clamps and the handrail
- Set the handrail upside down on a protected surface
- Remove the dome screw and then the bracket top

#### Note:


To prevent possible corrosion, only use the supplied chrome plated Allen wrench when doing this step



- · Set the bracket top on the pre-marked locations
- Using a <sup>9</sup>/<sub>64</sub>" bit, drill the pilot holes for the handrail screws



## **Universal Bracket Handrail Installation Steps (Continued)**



- Attach the handrail brackets to the handrail with the provided screws
- Full Brackets: Populate all 6 holes
- Half Brackets: Populate all 4 holes
- Corner Brackets: Populate all 8 holes



- Place the handrail on top of the posts
- Secure the handrail bracket with both dome screws

#### Note:

To prevent possible corrosion, only use the supplied chrome plated Allen wrench when doing this step
