- 4. You'll go to the job site and verify site conditions. If the site is as-communicated, you'll take any necessary measurements.
- 5. You'll work with the Project Manager to get the order into production.
- 6. You'll install the system, take pictures, and receive sign-off from the customer when the job is complete.
- 7. You'll receive payment within 10 business days after a job has been signed off.

Referrals:

- 1. We'll gather information during the sales process and contact you with information about the project.
- 2. You'll work with the customer to determine your price for installation.
- 3. You'll work with the Project Manager to get the order into production.
- 4. After delivery, the rest of the project will be up to you, including communication with the client, final sign-off, and payment
