





Aluminum Slim Side Mount Post Installation Guide



Tools Needed for this Installation




• All posts are designed to be mounted to a non-compressible surface. They will not mount properly to drywall or carpet Visit our YouTube channel to watch helpful installation videos youtube.com/viewrail

Aluminum Slim Side Mount Post Installation Steps



- Refer to your project drawing and lay out your posts, keeping the posts 4' or less apart
- Place your end posts in position and line up the middle of the post with where you will be mounting the dove tail plate
- It may be helpful to mark a vertical line at this point

STRUCTURE

- Place the dove tail plate into position, making sure the plate is square
- The top of the plate should be 1³/₈" beneath the surface of the deck
- If you are mounting on a skirtboard / side of stairs, you will need to move the posts and mount wherever creates a 36" handrail height




• Using a 1/4" drill bit, predrill all 3 holes



- With 3" or more of blocking, wood lags or through bolts can be used
- Use the T-30 drill bit to begin fastening the 5/16" x 4" wood lags into the top two holes of the dove tail plate
- Shim as needed until plumb




Aluminum Slim Side Mount Post Installation Steps (Continued)



- Once the top two lags are securely fastened, use the ⁵/₁₆" wrench to begin fastening the ⁵/₁₆" x 4" hex head lag into the bottom hole of the dove tail plate
- Leave ³/₄" of the hex head lag exposed



- Slide the Foam Insert into each post
- This ensures that the rods will not rattle & make noise



- Slide the post into the dove tail plate
- The slot cut into the bottom of the post should slide down and onto the exposed hex head lag




• Once the post is fully seated in place, use the wrench to reach up through the bottom of the post and fully fasten the hex head lag




Aluminum Slim Side Mount Post Installation Steps (Continued)




- Now that the end posts are in place, lay out a string or chalk line evenly between the posts
- Ensure that the string is $1^{3}\!/_{8}"$ beneath the surface of the deck



- Begin to set and mark the dove tail plates for the other posts on the run
- Repeat steps 2-8 for the remaining plates



- If needed, loosen and refasten the posts as needed to even out the handrail height for your local code compliance
- Handrails should never be less than 36" in height



• Using a dead blow hammer, tap the end cap into the bottom of each post

Note: If your railing system contains both Slim Side Mount Posts as well as standard Side Mount Posts (e.g. Outside or Inside Corner Posts) it will be necessary to ensure that you are using the correct 2x2 Post Press-In Plug. Slim Side Mount Posts use a plug with a oval cut through the center for drainage and a circular hole in one of the corners that doesn't go all the way through. The orientation of the plug in this application does not matter.
